

College Profile

Government Degree College, Dharampur, Solan was founded on June 11, 2014, with a vision to provide exceptional education in the fields of Arts and Commerce. The college started in the Block Elementary Education office building in the center of Dharampur town. The college has now embarked on a new journey with the construction of a new campus being built on Mandodhar hill, surrounded by pine trees. The campus was inaugurated on March 1, 2024, by the Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh, marking a significant milestone in the college's history.

Vision

The college stands for creating and sustaining the conditions that enable all college students to experience an unparalleled educational journey that is intellectually, socially, and personally transformative.

Mission

The College aims to mould the students hailing mostly from the rural areas, marginalized and weaker sections of the society into better individuals and to guide them to contribute constructively towards the society. The college also aims at imparting quality education to the students and equips them to cope with the latest

requirements in professional and social spheres through innovative techniques and practices.

Staff

The college has a total number of 13 sanctioned posts in the teaching faculty and out of these 10 posts are filled on a regular basis, 03 posts are lying vacant in various subjects. In the non-teaching staff, the college has 05 sanctioned posts and out of which 04 are filled up and 01 is lying vacant in various categories. There are five sanctioned posts of peons in this college out of which three are filled and two are vacant.

Enrollment

Achievements

The years 2023-24 and 2024-25 are witness to many events and success stories of the college. All the success can be attributed to the dedication and team spirit of the staff (teaching as well as non-teaching) and students of this prestigious institution.

We are privileged to announce that this year our college was inspected by the SAR (Self-Assessment Report) team of Internal Assessment and Ranking of the Govt. College of Himachal Pradesh in 2024 and we have been ranked 20th out of 66 colleges in tier III of internal ranking of Govt. colleges of Himachal Pradesh.

We have also entered into an academic partnership with the Department of Agriculture & Horticulture and Waste Warrior society. This strategic alliance, formalized by signing a memorandum of Understanding (MoU), will encourage innovation, sustainability and collaborative research endeavors.

1) The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on 23 September, 2024 between the Government Degree College, Dharampur Distt. Solan and the Department of Horticulture, Dharampur for promoting skill development, natural and organic farming related skills among the students. The objective of the MoU

- was to enhance gardening practices and farming skills among the students by organizing various workshops and conduction of practical training.
- 2) Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the Government Degree College, Dharampur Distt. Solan and Department of Agriculture, Dharampur on 24th September, 2024. The purpose of the MoU is to foster the natural farming skills by harnessing the natural resources for the development of a sustainable system of agriculture in the hilly areas. Seven-day training workshop was also organized on Natural & Organic farming in collaboration with the Department of Agriculture from 25th December, 2024 to 31st, December, 2024 to train the students.
- 3) Govt. College Dharampur signed a Memorandum of Understanding (Mou) with Waste Warriors Society, a nonprofit organization, Kasauli Distt. Solan on 3rd October, 2024. The aim of the MoU is to promote recycling practices, minimize waste generation, advocate laws and policies that regulate waste reduction and to raise awareness for waste reduction.

Adoption of Schools

We have collaborated with many GSS Schools as per Govt instructions and adopted many schools namely Govt. Model Sr. Sec. School Rajri-Jabli, Govt. Sr. Sec. School Dharampur, Govt. Centre Primary School Dharampur, Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Chamian, Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Kanda, Govt. Sr. Sec. School Rauri, Govt. Sr. Sec. School Parwanoo, Govt. Primary School Bhera-ka-khech. Teachers of our college visited these schools and delivered lectures on various topics like career counseling, drug addiction, stress management and motivational talks.

We aim to provide mentorship and support to school students, sensitizing them about education opportunities after class XII and empowering them to achieve their educational goals.

Scholarships

Financial support in form of scholarship is provided to meritorious, needy and deserving students by recognizing their academic excellence, talent and potential. This year 08 students are verified for scholarship schemes of the state including IRDP, Kalpana Chawla Chhatravritti Yojna, Post Matric Scholarship Scheme to SC & ST students, Dr.Ambedkar Post Matric scholarship scheme for the economically backward classes, Post-Matric scholarship scheme to OBC students.

Cultural & Co-curricular Activities

Cultural and co-curricular activities are vital components of formal education, playing a significant role in shaping and enhancing individual educational experience. Our college is providing such opportunities to the students in the college itself and outside it, ensuring holistic development and a richer educational experience.

Participation in Youth Festivals Organized by Himachal Pradesh University

- i) In the year 2023, for the first time, students of our college participated in Group-I activities namely: Quiz, declamation and debate competition held at Govt. Physical Education & Sports

Although our college does not have Physical Education subject and teacher but the college has always been actively involved in various sports activities under the guidance of Dr. S.K. Negi, sports in charge of our college.

In the session 2023-24 our college students participated in following sports championships organized by the H.P. University. A team of six students namely: Arpit Thakur, Naveen Sharma of BA-II, Pranjal Thakur, Paras Kumar Bansal, Rishi Ranjan Singh of B.Com-II and Devang Sharma of B.Com-I represented our college in HP University Inter College Badminton Championship held at Govt. College Sunni Distt. Shimla from 7th November, 2023 to 9th November, 2023.

Annual athletic meet of the college was held on 10th February, 2024 in the school ground. Events like 100m, 400 m and 800 m races, shot put, javelin throw, and long jump were organized. More than 110 students participated in the event. Nitesh of B.Com-III year was declared best athlete men and Mehak of B.A-I year was declared best athlete women for the session 2023-2024.

Clubs/Societies & Activities

Eco Club

The Eco Club is a vibrant and proactive group dedicated to promoting environmental awareness and is working under the guidance of Dr. Bavita.

- i) To boost environment sensitization among students, on 4th March, 2024 a competition on collecting maximum number of herbal/medicinal plants of local areas was organized in which 50 local medicinal/herbal plants were collected and planted by the students.
- ii) The club organized a two-day campus cleanliness drive from 7th November, 2024 to 8th November, 2024.

Red Ribbon Club

The Red Ribbon club of the college works to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS and healthy lifestyles. Under the guidance of Dr. Gagandeep Garg following activities were undertaken:
