Education is considered to be a Panacea. The word 'education' literally means 'to bring out'. In common parlance, the term 'education' implies systematic and scholastic instruction and cultivation of physical, intellectual, aesthetic, and moral faculties. The endeavors of the Government of India through the **Swachhata hi Seva campaign** aim at orienting anthropogenic activities as **Swabhav Swachhata Sanskaar Swachhata** to imbibe the spirit in every action on a day-to-day basis & to inculcate the sensitivity towards environmental concerns as envisioned and aimed through Sustainable Development Goals. Youth involvement in Waste Management practices is crucial for fostering sustainable environmental practices. Young people bring energy, innovation, and a willingness to adopt new technologies and approaches to waste reduction, recycling, and awareness campaigns.

Inspired by the philosophy of 'Be the change you want to see in others' and 'Swachhata hi Seva', there is a need to undertake youth-led initiatives that can drive societal change by raising awareness of the environmental impacts of waste and encouraging sustainable behavior, ensuring long-term ecological conservation for the future generation.

The Areas of Cooperation include:

1. Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) establishes a collaborative framework between Government Degree College Dharampur, Solan (hereafter referred to as The First Party) and Waste Warriors (hereafter referred to as "Second Party) to promote sustainable waste management practices and environmental awareness within the college community.

2. Objectives

The primary objectives of this MoU are:

- To enhance waste management practices on campus.
- To conduct workshops and seminars on waste segregation, recycling, and sustainability.
- To engage students and faculty in community clean-up drives and awareness campaigns.

- To foster a culture of environmental responsibility among students, staff, and Community.

3. Roles and Responsibilities

3.1. Government Degree College Dharampur:

- Provide access to college facilities for workshops and events organized by Waste Warriors.
- Facilitate the participation of students and faculty in awareness programs and community initiatives.
- Promote the partnership through college communication channels.

3.2. Waste Warriors:

- Organize and conduct training sessions, workshops, and clean-up drives in collaboration with the College.
- Provide expertise and resources for effective waste management practices.
- Support the College in developing educational materials and campaigns.

The scope of this MoU is expandable and terms and conditions will be mutually agreed upon on a case-by-case basis. MoU shall take effect from the date of signature and will remain in effect for two years. This MoU is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement on the year to year basis. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the MoU at any time, although such action will only take place after mutual consultation to avoid any possible inconvenience to the parties.

This MoU is non-binding and has no legal and monetary implications for either party.


